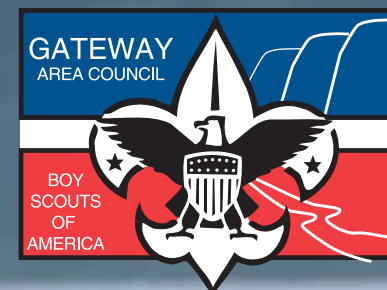

ABOUT THE ARTIST:

Onalaska, Wisconsin, resident Art Anderson has pursued his interest in painting ever since his early years in grade school. After attending UW-Eau Claire and the Art Instructional School of Minneapolis, MN, he eventually moved to western Wisconsin to continue his research on the wildlife abundant along the Mississippi River. Precise detail and realism are of the highest standard in his landscape and wildlife images. He has garnered numerous honors for his work including Federal and State Duck Stamps, and National and State Turkey Stamps, and most recently the 2010 Wisconsin Wild Turkey stamp. His original and limited edition prints are in private and corporate collections throughout the United States, Canada and Norway.

The majestic view of the Black River from the Council Firebowl at Camp Decorah is truly frozen in time in this first in series of limited edition prints by award winning Wisconsin artist, Art Anderson. A place of tranquility and reflection, the Firebowl often resonates with the sound of laughter, song and ceremony as Scouts, staff and family frequently assemble here. The Black River is home to many American bald eagles and it is not hard to envision they would choose this place to rest and survey their domain. Nor it is hard to imagine any number of Scouts who have chosen to rest here, and found inspiration for their personal trail to Eagle Scout.

Prints of Art Anderson's original oil painting, entitled "An Eagles Respite", are now available! All prints are signed and numbered by the artist. A limited edition Executive Series (75) are available with a beautiful color remarque, a detailed hand painted image in the margin of the print for \$195.00. In addition, a limited edition 420 print series is available with or without a pencil remarque (\$110.00 or \$140.00 respectively). The pencil remarque is a precise hand drawn pencil image, by the artist, also in the margin of the print. Actual print size is 25 1/2"X 19 1/2". All prints are individually wrapped in acid free paper, and include a cardboard folder, a Certificate of Authenticity and a 25 % discount coupon for framing at The Frame Gallery in Holmen, WI.

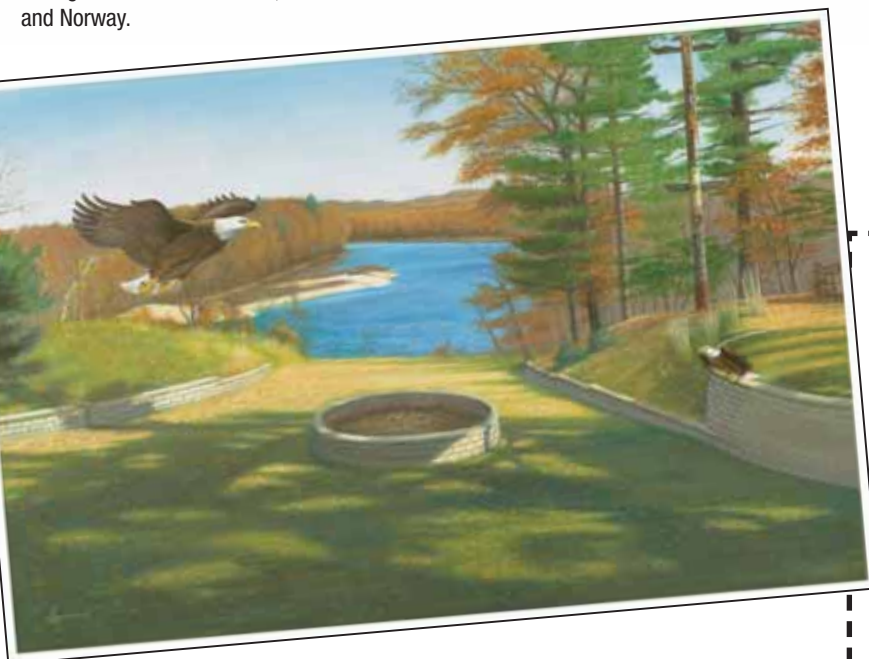
